- 1 Two-Spirit is a term for Indigenous people who identify as having a masculine and feminine spirit. It describes Indigenous ways of expressing sexual, gender and spiritual identification
- 2 BIPOC stands for Black, Indigenous and People of Colour
- 3 Disability is understood as any physical, mental, developmental, cognitive, learning, communication, sight, hearing, or functional limitation that, in interaction with a barrier, hinders a person's full and equal participation in society
- 4 STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math
